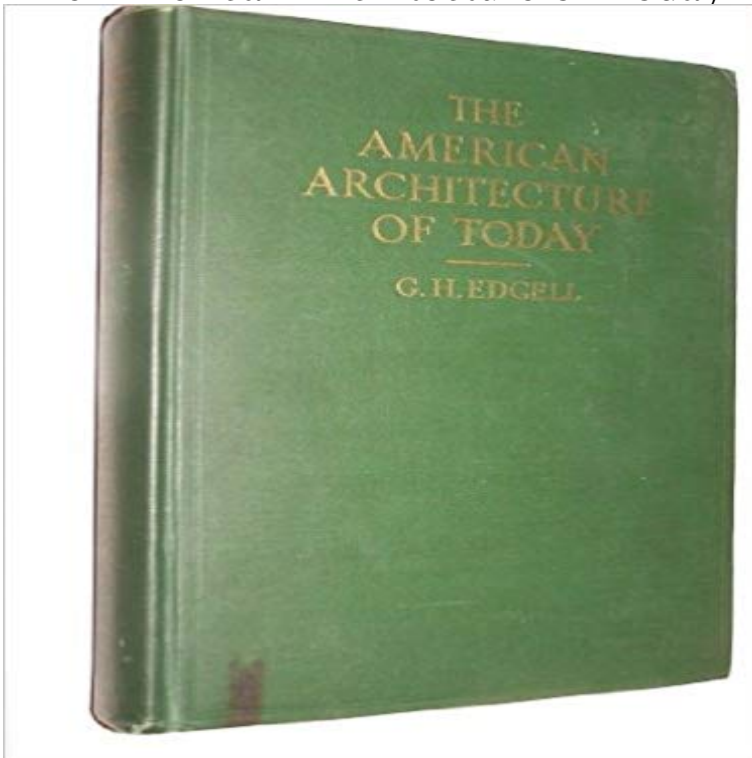


The American Architecture of Today
