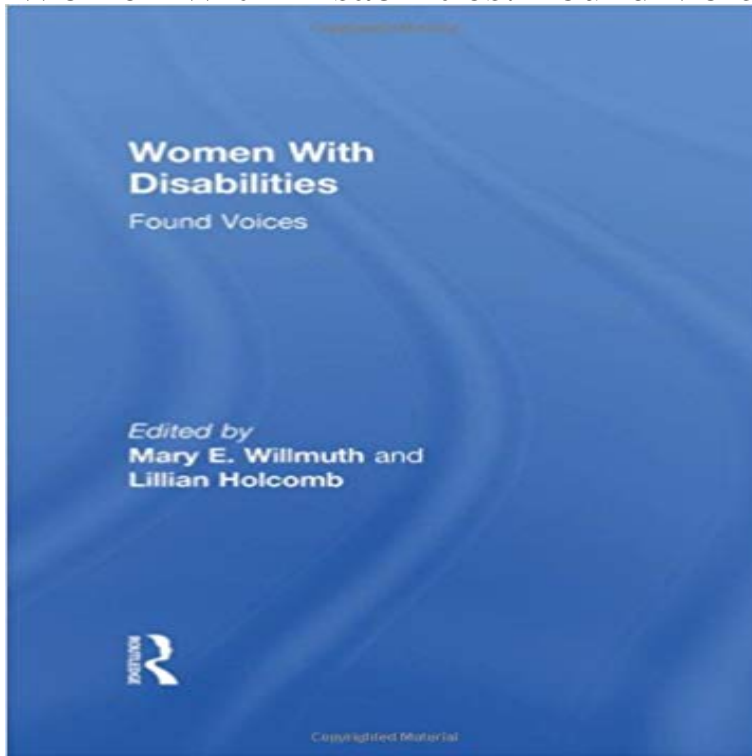


## Women With Disabilities: Found Voices
