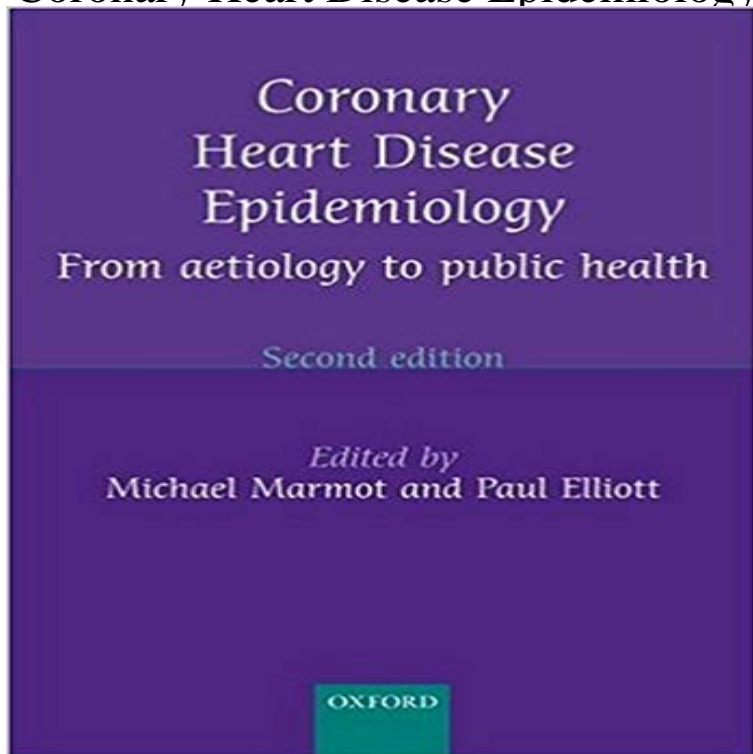


## Coronary Heart Disease Epidemiology (Oxford Medical Publications)
