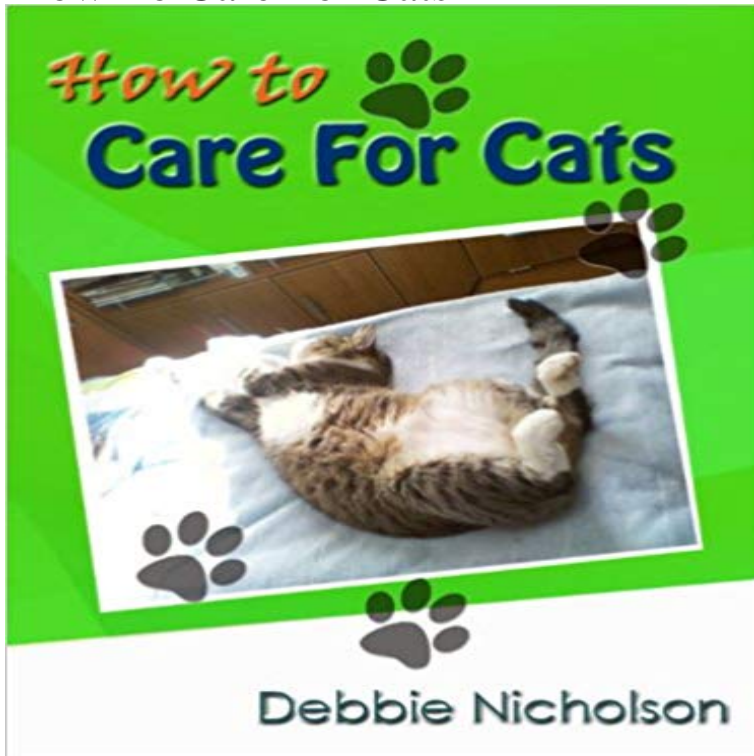


How To Care For Cats
