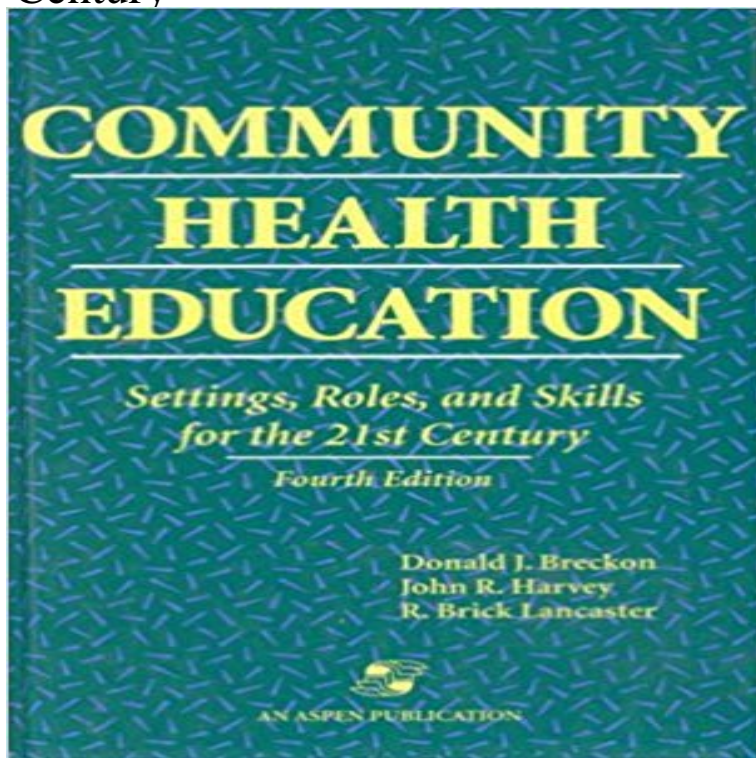


Community Health Education: Settings, Roles, and Skills for the 21st Century
