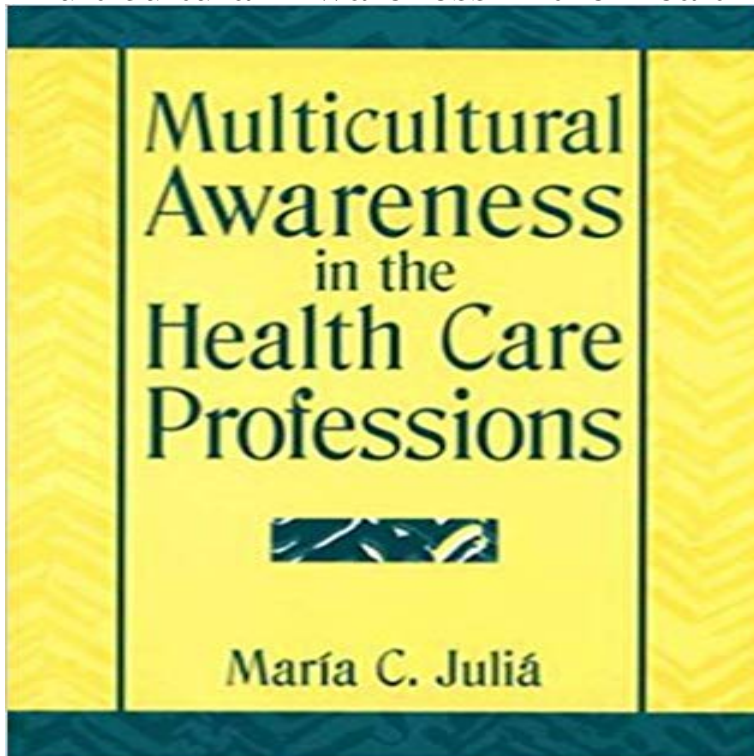


Multicultural Awareness in the Health Care Professions
