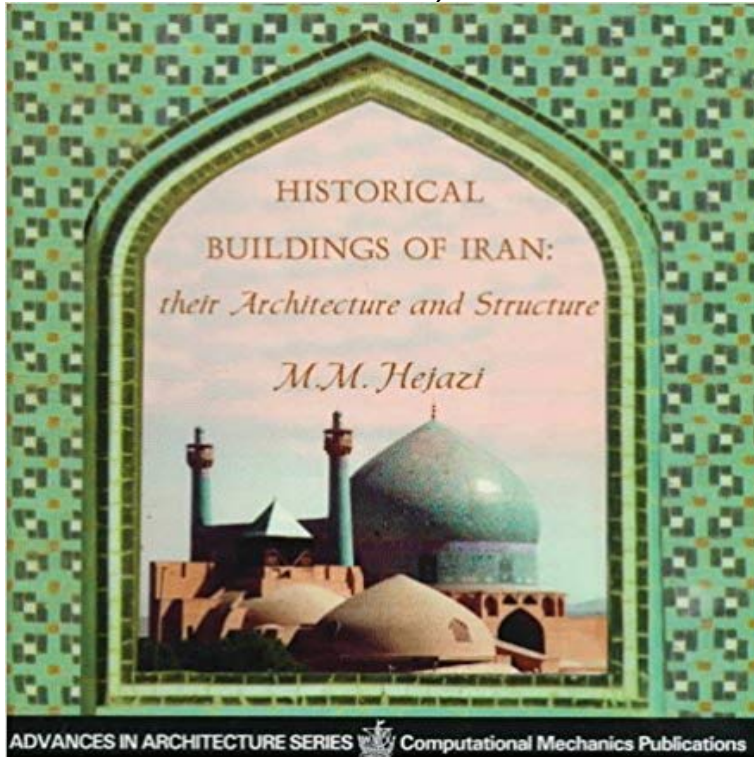


Historical Buildings of Iran: Their Architecture and Structure (Advances in Architecture Series)

Special parts of the book deal with structural analysis of historical domes, minarets and a wooden structure followed by maintenance comments. The last part of the book proposes several historical structures as research topics for future work.
