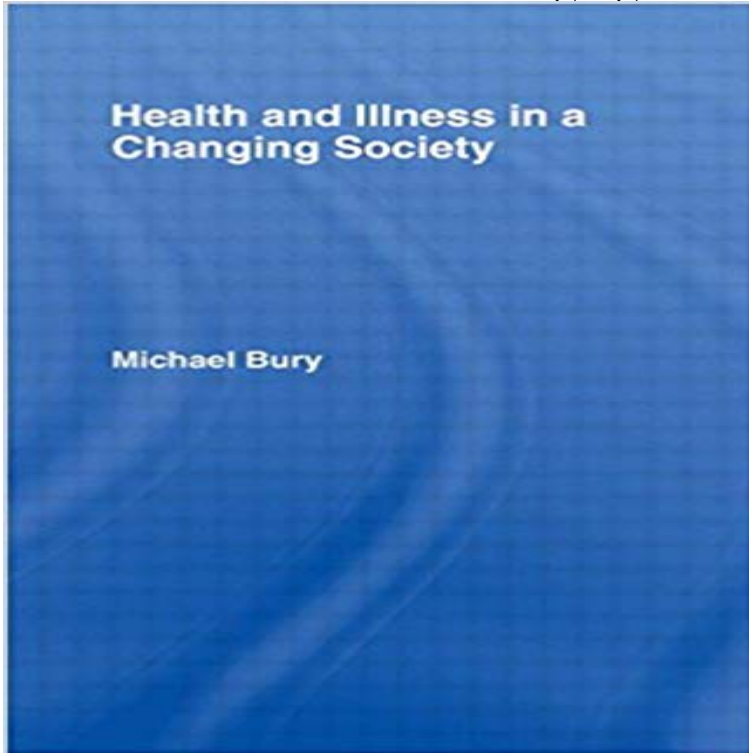


Health and Illness in a Changing Society
