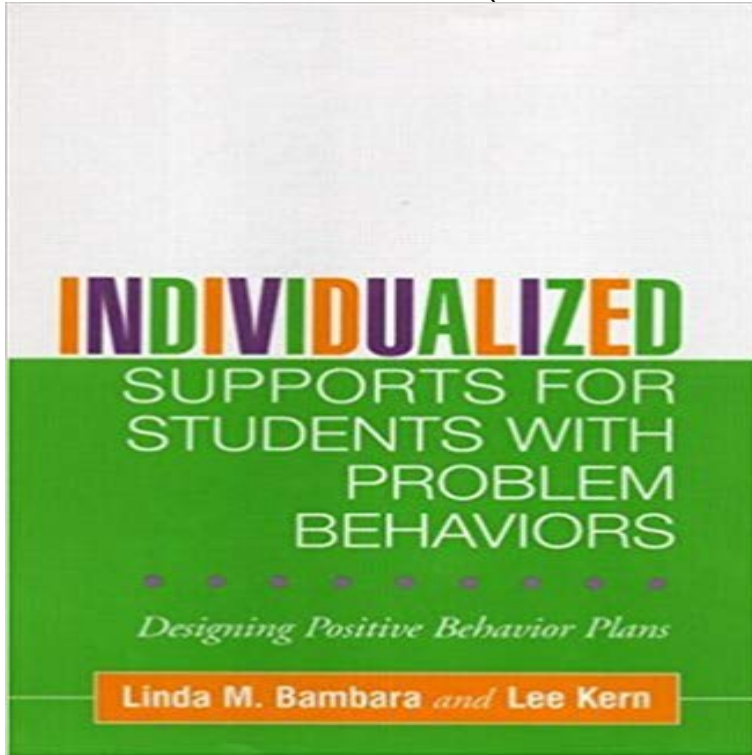


Individualized Supports for Students with Problem Behaviors: Designing Positive Behavior Plans (Guilford School Practitioner)
