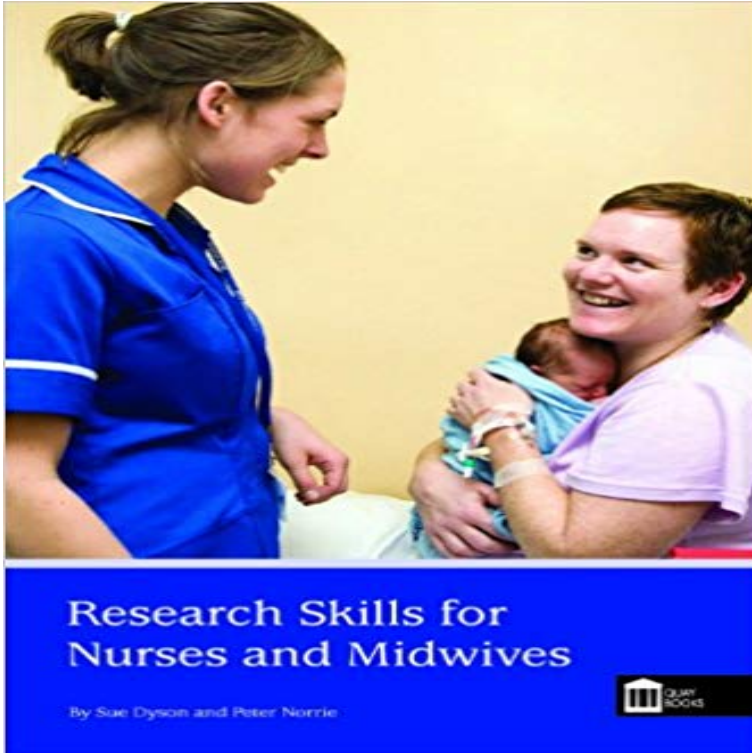


Research Skills for Nurses and Midwives
