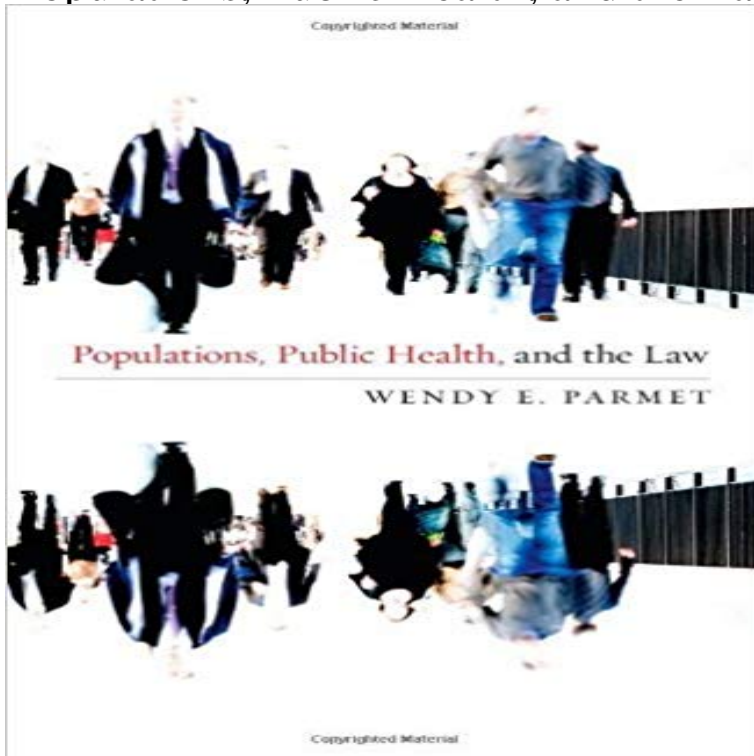


# Populations, Public Health, and the Law
