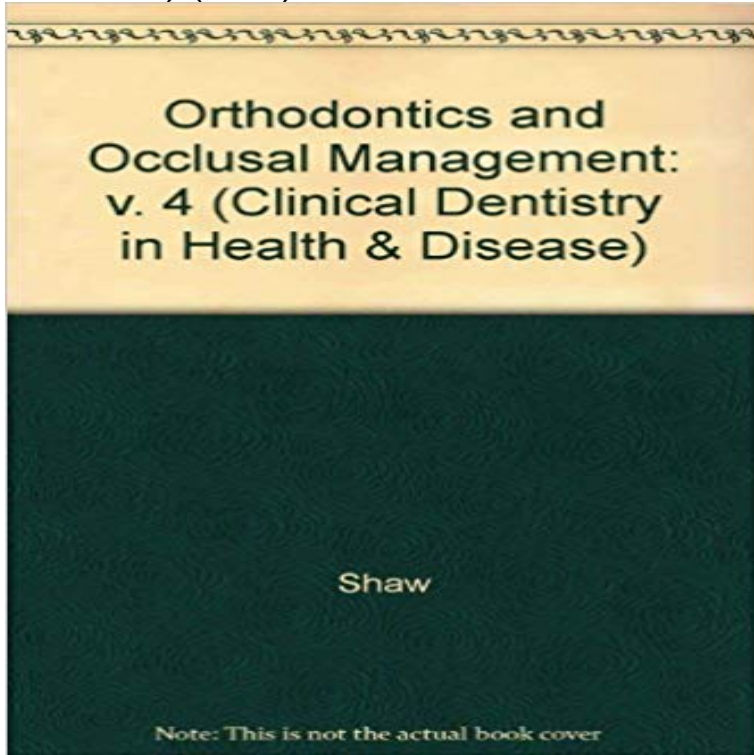


Orthodontics and Occlusal Management (Clinical Dentistry in Health & Disease) (v. 4)

At a practical level the use of removable, myofunctional and fixed appliances and their everyday management is fully described and illustrated, and the specialised treatment of major dentofacial anomalies is outlined. Significant sections on the assessment and management of mandibular dysfunction and the ageing dentition have been included.
