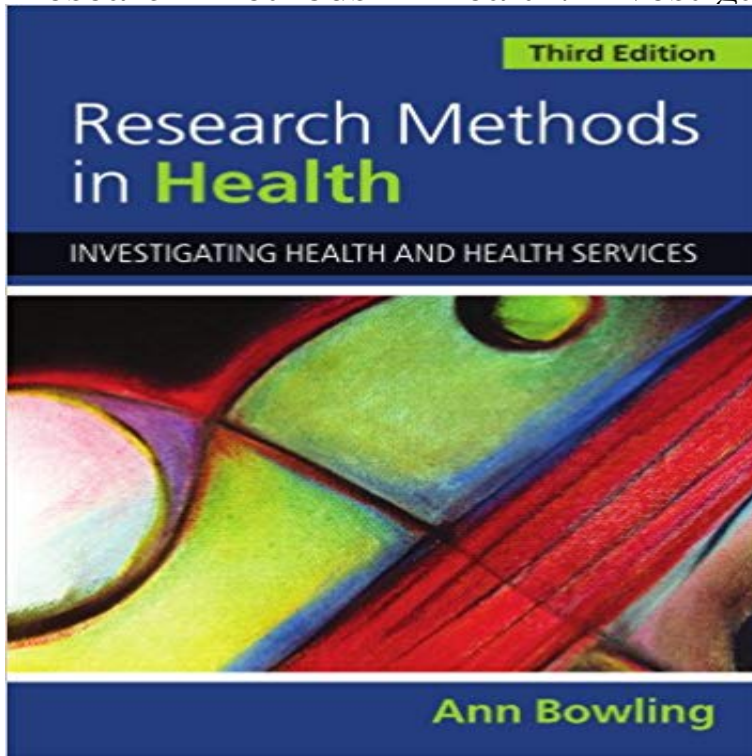


# Research Methods in Health: Investigating Health and Health Services
