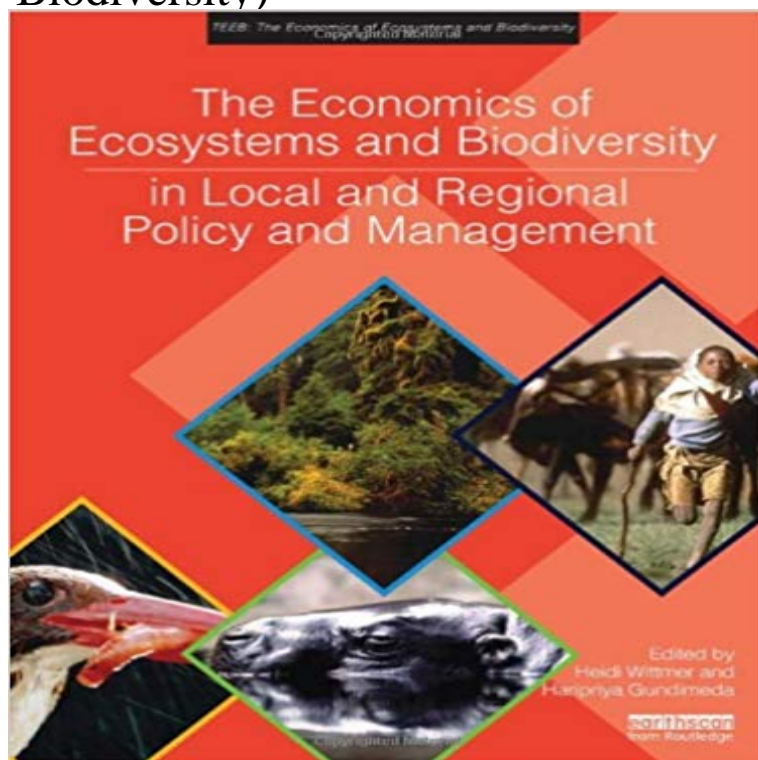


## The Economics of Ecosystems and Biodiversity in Local and Regional Policy and Management (TEEB - The Economics of Ecosystems and Biodiversity)
