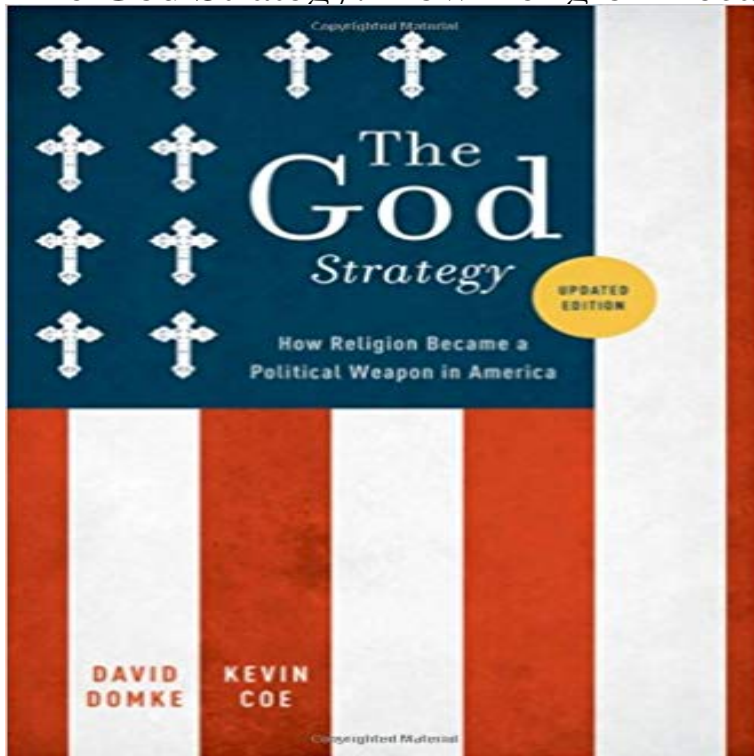


# The God Strategy: How Religion Became a Political Weapon in America
