

Substance Abuse of Adolescents



Identify adolescents substance use and intervene, as even occasional use may result in serious health risks. Identify possible suicidal tendencies and refer a psychotic patient to psychiatric emergency care. Contact the parents of adolescents below 18 years of age even though the use of substances seems to be occasional. Contact child protection authorities when needed.
