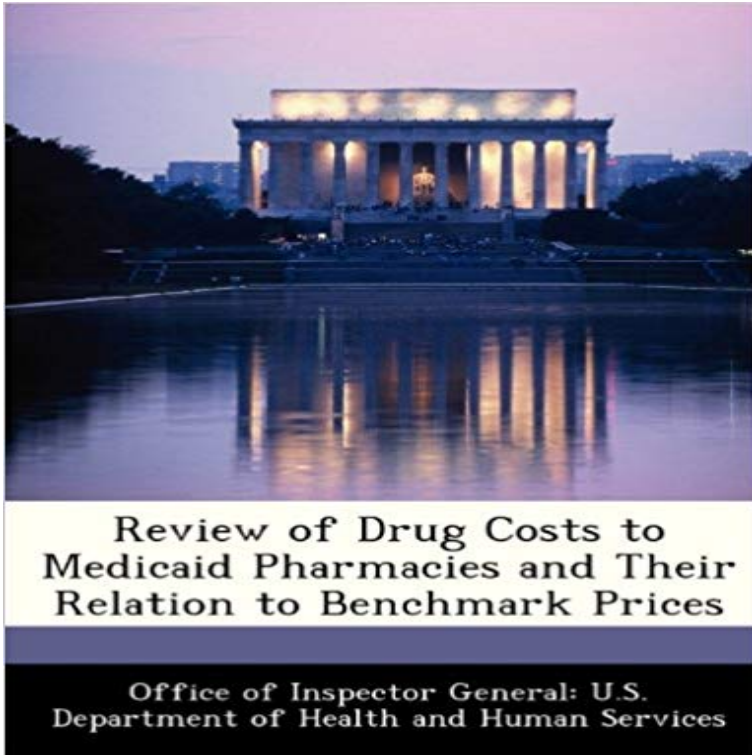


Review of Drug Costs to Medicaid Pharmacies and Their Relation to Benchmark Prices
